Mill 6 Presents the Boston Premiere of *Underneath the Lintel*Off-Broadway Smash Opens Feb 17th in the South End

Would you recognize a miracle if you saw one? A mystery shrouded in faith is unlocked when a Dutch librarian sets out on an ancient quest to find the man who returned a book, 113 years overdue.

Underneath the Lintel originally opened in New York in September 2001 and ran Off-Broadway for over 15 months and 450 performances. It won the 2001 Los Angeles Ovation Award for Best Play, the Garland Award for Best Playwriting and was selected one of **Time Out New York's Best Plays of 2001**. Mill 6 is thrilled to present the **Boston premiere** of this acclaimed play.

Glen Berger is playwright-in-residence at New York Stage & Film. He's received numerous awards, a Manhattan Theatre Club/Sloan Foundation Grant, and a National Foundation for Jewish Culture Grant.
